Look out for updates on both, via email and WhatsApp.







New WCC myClubhouse Software


This is an app, or for traditional laptop people, a website, where you will be able to:

- Buy climb tokens, much like we do at the moment with the 5-pack or 10-pack climbs
- See how many climbs you have left!
- Peruse the club events and sign up to any that you want to go to
- And much more.

It will come as no surprise that all this advanced technology will come at a cost for the club, but the Committee has decided that it is feasible to run a pilot at no cost to you as members.
